


The Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability and Office of Educational Quality and Accountability (OEQA) strive to provide the most timely and comprehensive information regarding Oklahoma’s public schools. The *State Profiles* is an annual report aggregating many of the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program’s statistics to the state level. Per §70-1210.531, the *State Profiles* delivers, “A summary report to the people and Legislature of Oklahoma of the information provided by the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program.”

The Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program provides school site, district, state, and national educational statistics derived from a number of sources. These sources include the Census Bureau’s American Community Survey, Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE), Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education (OSRHE), Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs, National Center for Education Statistics, ACT, Inc., The College Board, and all Oklahoma public schools. This program has proven to be vital to parents, researchers, grant writers, school administrators, legislators, and the general public.





% Students as Economically Disadvantaged 2021 - 2022 School Year

% Students Identified as English Language Learners 2021 - 2022 School Year




Incoming Student Mobility Rates 2021 - 2022 School Year

% KG-3rd Grade Students in Reading Remediation 2021 - 2022 School Year





2021 - 2022 School Year










2021 - 2022 School Year





2021 - 2022 School Year











2021 - 2022 School Year





2021 - 2022 School Year







2021 - 2022 School Year











2021 - 2022 School Year







% Students Scoring Proficient or Above




Average ACT Scores Based on Highest Score 2022 Graduates




Average GPA of High School Seniors 2021 - 2022 School Year




% Juniors/Seniors Served by CareerTech 2021 - 2022 School Year


% High School Graduates Completing College-Bound Curriculum 2021 - 2022 School Year


% Graduates Earning OK Promise 2022 HS Graduates


Oklahoma College-Going Rates of High School Graduates 2019 - 2021 School Years


Out-of-State College-Going Rates of High School Graduates 2022 School Year


% College Freshmen Taking at Least One Remedial Course 2019-2021 School Years


% College Freshman with GPA 2.0 or Above 2019-2021 School Years


Number of Oklahoma College Degrees Conferred to High School Graduated Alumni 2021 - 2022 College Year


% District Revenue by Source District 2021 - 2022 School Year


% District Revenue by Source State Dedicated 2021 - 2022 School Year


% District Revenue by Source State Appropriated 2021 - 2022 School Year


% District Revenue by Source Federal 2021 - 2022 School Year



Public School Sample







2022 NAEP Results by State - 4th Grade Math


% Students at Advanced Public School Sample


2022 NAEP Results by State - 4th Grade Reading Average Scale Score Public School Sample

2022 NAEP Results by State - 4th Grade Reading % Students at Proficient or Above Public School Sample



% Students at Advanced Public School Sample





Public School Sample







% Students at Advanced Public School Sample







2022 NAEP Results by State - 8th Grade Reading


% Students at Advanced Public School Sample

ACT Average Composite Score ACT-Tested HS Graduates Class of 2022





ACT-Tested HS Graduates




% Meeting ACT College Readiness Benchmark - Reading ACT-Tested HS Graduates Class of 2022


% Meeting ACT College Readiness Benchmark - Math ACT-Tested HS Graduates Class of 2022

% Meeting ACT College Readiness Benchmark - Science ACT-Tested HS Graduates Class of 2022





























Unemployment Rate among Population with Bachelor's Degree or Higher (Age 25-64)


